Sub: Grant of leave on Medical grounds based on Certificates issued by RMPs/AMAs under Ayurvedic/Homoeopathic system of Medicine.


The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department circular of even No./858 dated 18.11.2002 and circular of even no./859 dated 18.11.2002 on the above subject.

2. It is hereby clarified that the Medical Certificates issued by Doctors with BAMS/BIIMS degrees who have registered themselves with the Indian Medical Council as provided in Para-3 of the Circular first cited would be acceptable for grant of leave for short spells of upto 5 days (6 days in the case of employees in industrial units) only.

3. With reference to the Para-3 of the circular second cited, it is clarified that the Medical Certificate issued by the RMP/AMA should be got endorsed from CHSS Medical Officer by the concerned employee before resuming duty. In any rare case if an employee is unable to get the Medical Certificate issued by RMP/AMA endorsed from the CHSS Medical Officer before resuming duty due to genuine practical difficulties, such endorsement should be got done by the employee at the earliest and in any case within one week from date of resuming duty.

4. The above points may please be brought to the notice of all the concerned employees of your Unit.
