

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Coverage of Contributory Health Services Scheme to the employees in Aided Institutions

For the purpose of medical treatment, the Department of Atomic Energy is covered under a special scheme, i.e. the Contributory Health Services Scheme. Accordingly, this scheme has been introduced in various Units of the Department. Although the Scheme is meant only for the employees in the Department, i.e. the Government servants, as a temporary arrangement, the staff of certain Aided Institutions located in some parts of the country are also allowed to make use of the medical facilities under the scheme.

2. It may be noted, however, that this facility is available to the employees of Aided Institutions (except T.I.F.R.) only so long as they are in service and will not be extended to them after their retirement on superannuation. This may be brought to the notice of your employees.
