

Subject: Introduction of Contributory Health Service Scheme at HWP, Baroda.

Vide this Department's O.M. of even number dated September 23, 1998, the Contributory Health Service Scheme as notified vide O.M. No. 7/55/94/CHSS/IR&W/37 dated January 22, 1998 was extended mutatis mutandis to the officers, staff, their family members and dependents in the DAE establishments at Baroda. It is clarified that in addition to the employees in Heavy Water Plant, AMD, DPS, SHRI Project of BARC, the employees of the NPCIL and their family members stationed at Baroda would also be eligible to become members of the Baroda CHSS. However, this is subject to payment of per capita expenditure by the NPCIL to the HWB. All other terms and conditions as stipulated in the OM dated January 22, 1998 and September 23, 1998 in this regard would be applicable to the NPCIL employees.


