GCNEP, DAE signs MoU with the Vietnam Atomic Energy Institute (VINATOM)

During the visit of H.E. Mr. Tran Dai Quang, President of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam to India, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between the Global Centre for Nuclear Energy Partnership (GCNEP), Department of Atomic Energy and the Vietnam Atomic Energy Institute (VINATOM). Dr. Sekhar Basu, Secretary DAE and Chairman, AEC signed the MoU on behalf of Government of India. The MoU was exchanged in presence of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi and the President of Vietnam.

The MoU strengthens capacity building and technical capabilities of VINATOM and co-operation in the field of atomic energy for peaceful purposes. Further the MoU facilitates organizing training, seminars, workshops and lectures by research experts from both sides on topical issues to develop a pool of trained human resource. The MoU will be valid for a period of 5 years and will be renewed automatically thereafter with mutual consultations.

Dr. Sekhar Basu, Chairman, AEC also participated in the delegation level talks led by the Hon'ble Prime Minister.
